An Emergency Preparedness Officer, is currently the Division Director, Diplomatic Contingency Programs (DCP) Division, Office of Emergency Management, U. S. Department of State.

As the DCP Division Director, Mr. Mock serves as the Department's Program Manager for the Department's Continuity Programs – specifically the Continuity of Operations (COOP) and Continuity of Government (COG) programs, as well as other classified and unclassified emergency contingency and continuity programs. Mock has over 30 years experience in COOP/COG operations, starting initially with his 1974 collateral assignment to the Marine Corps Contingency Battle Staff to the present time.

In 1993, Mr. Mock assumed the responsibilities as Chief, Operations Division, Office of Diplomatic Contingency Programs (A/DCP). In January 1998, Mr. Mock was named Deputy Director, A/DCP. On September 11, 2001, Mr. Mock was detailed to the Federal Emergency Management Agency as a Foreign Affairs Liaison Officer, returning to the Department in September, 2003. On June 2005, he was named Division Director of his present office.

Mock is a recipient of several Department Superior Honor and Meritorious Honor Awards for his continuity and emergency preparedness duties.
